Overview

The purpose of The Crooked Road's Heritage Artist Directory is to highlight the heritage musicians of the 19 county, 4 city region of Southwest Virginia.

The unique talent that resides in The Crooked Road is due to the heritage music traditions of the mountains that have been handed down from generation-to-generation with Anglo-Celtic, European, African, Native American and other cultural influences. The melding of cultures and the geography of the mountains has encouraged thriving music including Old-Time, Bluegrass, Ballad Singing and Gospel as well as traditional dance, storytelling and instrument-making.

The Heritage Artist Directory strives to represent all aspects of traditional heritage music culture and provide a resource for those interested in learning more about the musicians, educators and event organizers who would like to include musicians in their programs and increase visibility for regional musicians.

Directory artists are selected based on application criteria by a committee made of active heritage musicians and parties knowledgeable about traditional music, dance and instrument genres. Categories include Bluegrass, Old-Time, Gospel, Ballad Singing, Blues, Stringband, Folk, Country, Traditional Dance, Luthier, and Storyteller.

Guidelines encompass proficiency, location, authenticity and cultural significance to Southwest Virginia. Legacy artists are selected by a committee of active musicians, venue operators and experts in the heritage music of Southwest Virginia.

The Crooked Road service region encompasses the following counties and cities of the Southwest Virginia region: Bland, Bristol, Buchanan, Carroll, Dickenson, Floyd, Franklin, Galax, Giles, Grayson, Lee, Montgomery, Norton, Patrick, Pulaski, Radford, Russell, Scott, Smyth, Tazewell, Washington, Wise, Wythe.

The Crooked Road will continue to expand the Heritage Music Directory in the future to continue to represent the wide range of traditional talent from Southwest Virginia.
